Dear friend of the Harbour Light,

Thank you for your continuing support of the Harbour Light of the Windwards radio station and missionary staff in Carriacou, Grenada. God continues to bless the outreach through AM and FM broadcasting and on the Internet. About 2.5 million people live within the station's normal coverage area. Based on listener responses and feedback, we believe that about 25,000 people or more listen for all or some part of the day. Many folks over the years have come to Christ. Others continue to be discipled. The ministry depends upon a team of Bible-believing broadcasters and upon another team of technical missionaries to run the station.

After a visit to the Harbour Light, the Lord burdened John and Sharon Steel to join the staff. The board of ARMS unanimously approved the Steel's application for service in Carriacou. John earned a bachelor's degree in Broadcast Engineering and then a master's degree in Broadcast Management from Bob Jones University. He has over 20 years of experience in various facets of broadcast engineering in the Lord's work including three years at the Caribbean Radio Lighthouse, our sister station in Antigua. John's primary duties will revolve around expanding the Harbour Light's ministry through the development of shortwave, repeaters, satellite technology, the Internet, and related means. Sharon is a registered nurse and has actively participated in ministry through children's clubs, Sunday school and women's Bible studies.

New missionaries often require several years on the field before understanding and contributing to the work. John and Sharon come to us with significant experience and maturity in Christian ministry! We believe that God will use them from the very first day!

ARMS now has two families on deputation! Pat and Janice Murphy are at about 33% of their needed support. The Murphy's recently purchased an RV to make visiting churches easier. Both of these couples are needed at the station. One of the ways that you could help them would be to communicate to them the names and addresses of like-minded churches for meetings.
