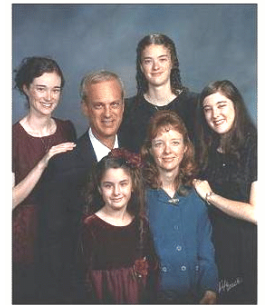
*“O, magnify the Lord with me,

Rolan Cornelius had been working with the station for two years while waiting for his bride, Arlene Bush, to finish her degree at Bob Jones University and come to join him in the radio ministry. He was excited as he watched R.G. LeTourneau's converted B-26 bomber land in Liberia with his bride. Three days later they were joined in marriage ... the date was Rolan's choice ... April 1, 1958 ... **fifty years ago** this month! During the ceremony they quoted Psalm 34:3 to each other and the Lord gave them 39 wonderful years together, magnifying His Name through missionary radio in Africa and the Caribbean. The Lord took Rolan Home to Heaven from Carriacou, Grenada on February 7<sup>th</sup>, 1997.

**Praise the Lord for His faithfulness** through all of these fifty years He has given me (Arlene) to continue serving Him. **Praise the Lord for the family** of four children He gave us during our 16 years of service in Liberia. (All of our children are Africans!) Now our children are serving the Lord in various countries and capacities.
